

1. If the beta version USB-DAC driver has been installed, then it can be found on the Device manager/ Sound, video, and game controllers as “iBasso Mango HiFi Audio Device”. Right click it, and uninstall it. If the beta version has not been installed, then skip the step 1.



2. Extract the zip, and click the setup.dat to start the installation.



3. After installation completed, turn on the DX50/DX90, press Settings→USB Settings, then select DAC.
4. Connect the DX50/DX90 to your computer, and select the “iBasso Mango Hifi Audio Device” as the audio output device. Then you can start using the DX50/DX90 as a USB-DAC.

Trouble Shooting:

If “iBasso Mango Hifi Audio Device” is not listed on the audio output device, then go to the Device Manager, you would see an exclamation mark beside the Mango Device. Update the driver by selecting the driver under the x86/mango-USB folder (if your OS is 32bit), or x64/mango-USB folder (if the OS is 64bit).
